

Teacher Training Program Entry Procedures

The School offers three full-time programs: the Professional Ballet/Academic Program, for students entering academic grades 6 through 12; the Post-Secondary Program, for pre-professional students who have completed high school; and the Teacher Training Program, for educating dance teachers at the post-secondary level.

The Teacher Training Program includes the following divisions: a 3 year diploma course; a 5 year joint program course with participating Universities; a 1 year certificate program; a 2 year diploma or 1 year certificate course for professional dancers. NBS also offers part-time programs and additional services that are outlined on the NBS website.

Admission to the School's Teacher Training Program is by Video audition or by an in person audition. **In person auditions will be conducted as follows:**

Vancouver, BC on Monday, October 29
Calgary, AB on Wednesday, October 31
St. John's, NL on Sunday, November 11
Halifax, NS on Monday, November 12

At Canada's National Ballet School in Toronto on Sunday, January 27, 2019.

Video auditions should be submitted by following the instructions provided on page 3 of this document and covering the CAD\$55 audition fee (payment to be made by money order or credit card only).

Entry requirements for the Teacher Training Program are as follows:

Three year diploma course

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Intermediate level of dance training

Five year joint program courses

- York University/Simon Fraser University program requirements must be met
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Intermediate level of dance training

One year certificate program

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Intermediate level of dance training

Professional Dancer courses (1 year certificate program and 2 year diploma program)

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Minimum 5 years' experience with a classically based and internationally recognized dance company

Please include a résumé and 2 letters of reference with all applications. The deadline for applications to be considered for the 2019/2020 school year is April 5, 2019. Late applications will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, and will be assessed based on space remaining in the program. Applicants will be notified by email as to whether or not they have been selected to attend the Second Stage Assessment which takes place April 30-May 3, 2019 for further evaluation.

Candidates from countries whose official languages do not include English may be asked to provide the Manager of the Teacher Training Program with scores from an international testing system, such as TOEFL or IELTS during the second stage audition week.

Classes begin in September 2019 and continue to June 2020, with extended breaks in December and April. Teacher Training students are responsible for their own accommodations. A limited number of spaces are available in the residence.

DVD Audition Requirements for entry to Teacher Training Program

NOTE: For those students applying for the Teacher Training Program for **Professional Dancers**, a performance video may be submitted in lieu of the following class work requirements. Students applying to the one-year certificate program and the three-year diploma program must submit the requirements listed below, in the order in which they are listed.

NB: All applicants must include a one to two minute talk about what motivated them to become trained as dance teachers.

BOTH FEMALE AND MALE

If a classical and/or contemporary variation is known, please present either or both

FEMALE

1. Barre work — 3-5 minutes of Barre work , incorporating both sides, to cover:

- a) pliés and port de bras
- b) tendus and glissés (jetés, degagés)
- c) adage with fondus
- d) grands battements and battements en clôche

Please position the camera in front of the applicant to show **FULL** height and breadth in pliés and port de bras. Please position the camera halfway between front and side for all other sections of the barre to show full range of movements.

2. Centre Practice — 5-10 minutes of Centre Practice, Adage and Pirouettes

- a) Centre Practice must show battement tendu combined with battement jeté in croisé, en face and effacé, devant and derrière.
- b) Adage must include grands ronds de jambe en l'air, a promenade in either à la seconde or arabesque, and a penché in 1st arabesque.
- c) Pirouettes may be from 5th, 2nd, or 4th position, and must be done on the right and the left sides, en dehors and en dedans.

3. Allegro — 5 to 10 minutes of Allegro to cover:

- a) 1 enchaînement terre à terre (quick steps).
- b) 1 enchaînement showing batterie.
- c) 1 enchaînement showing travelling jumps including waltzes, grand jeté en tournant and jeté en avant.

4. Pointe Work — 3-5 minutes of Pointe Work to include:

- a) simple echappé relevé in 2nd and 4th, retiré relevé and passé relevé.
- b) simple pirouettes from 4th position.
- c) couru en diagonale (bourrée)
- d) diagonal of piqué turns.

MALE

Numbers 1 to 3 inclusive plus:

- a) tour en l'air, single or double.
- b) an additional allegro to include grand batterie.
