The School's progressive curriculum, with its emphasis on the physical and emotional well-being of the student, has put NBS at the forefront of dance training internationally.

Making dance relevant to all persons through its philosophy of 'sharing dance' sees NBS engaging a diverse mix of participants, from school children to people living with Parkinson's Disease, in both on and off-site classes.

At Canada's National Ballet School, the health and safety of our students and onsite staff is a priority. The school, located in Toronto, seeks an experienced **NURSE PRACTITIONER** (full-time permanent). The Nurse Practitioner is the School's onsite healthcare representative and plays a vital role in the provision of health services for NBS' Professional Ballet Program students.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provides subject-matter expertise in the development of NBS health policies and protocols.
- Provides onsite nursing coverage during the school day. Provides supervision of on-call/part-time nursing staff.
- Leads prevention and screening services. Administers annual flu shot to students and onsite staff.
- Scope of practice activities may include assessment/treatment of acute illness, health promotion/protection, chronic disease management, crisis/disaster management, medical emergency response, mental health initiatives, and infectious disease prevention/management.
- Works with offsite provincially licensed physician to provide medical care to NBS students living in Residence.
- Communicates with NBS staff, families, and healthcare professionals as warranted in accordance with PHIPA and other relevant legislation.
- Documents care of students and staff in accordance with PHIPA and other relevant legislation.
- Facilitates the collection of immunization information as requested by Toronto Public Health (TPH) and reports communicable diseases according to TPH guidelines.

Qualifications/Skills/Experience:

- 2+ years working as a nurse practitioner in a healthcare environment.
- Licensed as a Nurse Practitioner in Ontario.
- CPR/AED certification.
- Knowledge of physical/emotional child development, childcare legislation and liability issues.
- Experience working with youth is an asset.
- Excellent assessment/judgment and communication skills (verbal and written).
- Able to work independently and to collaborate when appropriate.
- Good understanding of PHIPA and other legislation, which applies in a healthcare.

Successful candidates must supply Canada's National Ballet School with a current *Vulnerable Sector Reference Check*, in accordance with the School's Child Abuse/Sexual Abuse Prevention Policy; this will be coordinated through the Human Resources Department of NBS.
