NBS students perform in Japan's Orchard Ballet Gala

NBS Professional Ballet Program students Jason Chen, Arielle Miralles, Genevieve Penn-Nabity and Leo Hepler travelled to Tokyo, Japan to perform in the inaugural Orchard Ballet Gala on February 11 and 12, 2018. They performed two pas de deux; one from a newly commissioned work by Robert Binet, *Three Images of Hope*, and the second from *La Fille Mal Gardée*, choreographed by Alexander Gorsky.

The Orchard Ballet Gala was Japan's first international ballet forum planned in conjunction with world-renowned ballet schools. NBS dancers performed alongside students from professional ballet schools in Japan, Russia, Germany, Austria and The Netherlands.
