Professional Ballet Program students grow NBS Sharing Dance to new heights

This year, senior NBS students launched Project Acorn, a year-long initiative that utilized the 2018 Sharing Dance choreography to build stronger connections among students, their families, and the wider community. First, senior students taught the choreography to junior students, and then to their families during the annual parents weekend. When families returned home, they shared the choreography in their communities, growing the reach of the movement like an acorn grows a tree. The project helped students see the value in growing widespread appreciation for dance, and in sharing the benefits of the art form beyond NBS' walls.
